Background

The International Journal of Audiology is a peer-reviewed academic journal that aims to publish high-quality papers on the science and clinical practice of audiology. It is published monthly and is provided free-of-charge to all members of BSA online.

This is full access and includes access to archive copies of the Scandinavian Audiology Journal and the British Journal of Audiology, both of which merged with the International Journal of Audiology in 2001.

It is owned by the British Society of Audiology, the International Society of Audiology and the Nordic Society of Audiology.



Following the integration of Informa Healthcare into Taylor & Francis Group, the online journal access for British Society of Audiology members has transferred to Taylor & Francis's Online Platform. As a





result, we have had to move from Referrer Access to Trusted Proxy Server (TPS) - a more secure method of online access.

What does this mean in practical terms?

You can access the IJA from any link on the homepage of the BSA website but you need to SIGN IN first – see icon in top right hand corner of the homepage.

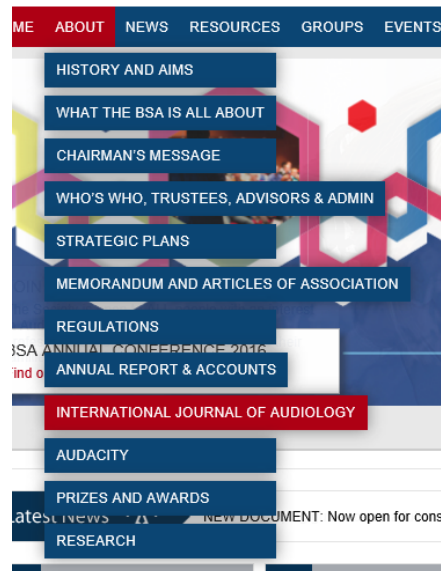


